



STANDARD GENERATOR INTERCONNECTION PROCEDURES (GIP)

Notice of UARB Decision Regarding NSPI Application to Amend the Generator Interconnection Procedures (“GIP”) – P-890

On August 6, 2008 NSPI submitted an application to the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board to obtain temporary relief from the Queue position requirements of the Generator Interconnection Procedures (GIP) and to establish a stakeholder process to consider revisions to the GIP. In its September 23, 2008 decision on the application, the UARB granted a temporary waiver to the GIP Queue and agreed that a stakeholder committee be established to consider revisions to the GIP. At the conclusion of the stakeholder process, NSPI filed its Revised GIP with the Board and it was approved on February 10, 2010 with an effective date of February 22, 2010.

Representatives from the NSPI System Operator will contact existing Interconnection Customers prior to this effective date regarding the necessary steps to transition Interconnection Requests to the revised GIP.

Interconnection Customers that do not wish to transition their Interconnection Request to the revised GIP may withdraw their project during the transition period by providing written notice to the NSPI System Operator. A refund will be provided for any deposits previously received from the Interconnection Customer (less any amounts utilized by the NSPI System Operator to conduct studies related to the Interconnection Request).
